IMPORTANT :

- Please, make sure to respect the quantities mentioned above.
- For better protection against the sun, **tank tops with small straps are prohibited.**
- MP3-4, laptops, cell phones, video game consoles or any other electronic devices **are prohibited.**
- Each article must be marked with the camper's name (**Sewed tags or use permanent markers**).
- Life jackets are provided by the camp.
- Bed linen is not supplied by the camp.

MÉDICAMENTS : If your child have to take any medication while at the camp:

- It is therefore important to always **return the original container identified with the child's name.** This label must include the name of the child, the name of the doctor, the name of the medicine, the expiry date, the dosage, and the duration of the treatment.
- You will have a form to complete when you arrive at camp.
