

Arrival, departure, and visits

Arrival: Sunday between 2 p.m. and 3 p.m. **Departure:** Friday from 6 h15 p.m. and 7 p.m.

For an optimal customer service, it is important to respect arrival and departure hours.

<u>Visits</u>: For children staying at the camp for 2 weeks or more (12 nights or more):

You can visit your child on Saturday between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

Important:

- Any person that wants to visit a child attending the camp must obtain the written authorization of the parents/legal guardians and submit it to the camp management.
- If your child is registered for two or more consecutive weeks, they stay at the camp between those weeks.
