- > Each article must be marked with the camper's name (sewed tags or use permanent markers).
- Life jackets are provided by the camp.
- Bed linen is not supplied by the camp.

## **MEDICATIONS:** If your child must take any medication while at the camp:

- It is therefore important to always <u>return the original container identified with the child's name</u>. This label must include the name of the child, the name of the doctor, the name of the medicine, the expiry date, the dosage, and the duration of the treatment.
